

## **REQUIRED PROOF OF FUNDING**

The University of Denver is required to verify that international students have sufficient funds to cover their educational and living expenses before issuing the immigration document needed to apply for F-1 status (Form I-20) or J-1 status (Form DS-2019).

These funds can be proven in the form of bank documents, awards from the University of Denver, sponsorships from outside the University, or any combination of these.

More information about this financial documentation can be found on the <u>Obtaining F-1 or J-1 Status</u> webpage in the *Proof of Funding* section.

- F-1 applicants must show sufficient funding for one academic year (3 quarters/2 semesters).
- J-1 applicants must show sufficient funding for the entire length of their program.

Students who plan to bring their spouse and/or dependent children under the age of 21 as F-2 or J-2 dependents will need to provide additional funding.

Spouse:\$5,200 per academic yearEach Child:\$3,960 per academic year
